

## Challenge of Rural Leadership



## Fees and Funding

The course fee for the 2026 Challenge of Rural Leadership is £6,700 per delegate, to include food and accommodation at Dartington Hall for two weeks. Programme materials are also included.

Most delegates attending the course are either fully or partially funded by their employer, business, personal contribution, or through sponsorship.

All candidates selected for interview will need to indicate during the interview, how they intend to fund their attendance, if a place is offered. They will also be required to confirm to the panel, that if a place is offered, they are confident of obtaining the funding required to take up that place.
